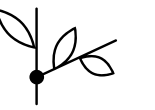

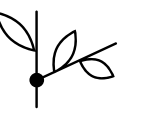

In the autumn of 2022, large demonstrations broke out in Iran. People protested against the oppression of women. The protests were suppressed with great brutality.



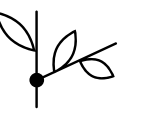

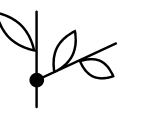

Narges Mohammadi began her fight for gender equality while still a student in the 1990s.

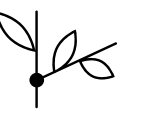




Freedom for all

The Nobel Peace Prize 2023 was awarded to a person who is fighting for human rights. Over the decades, many human rights defenders have received the prize.

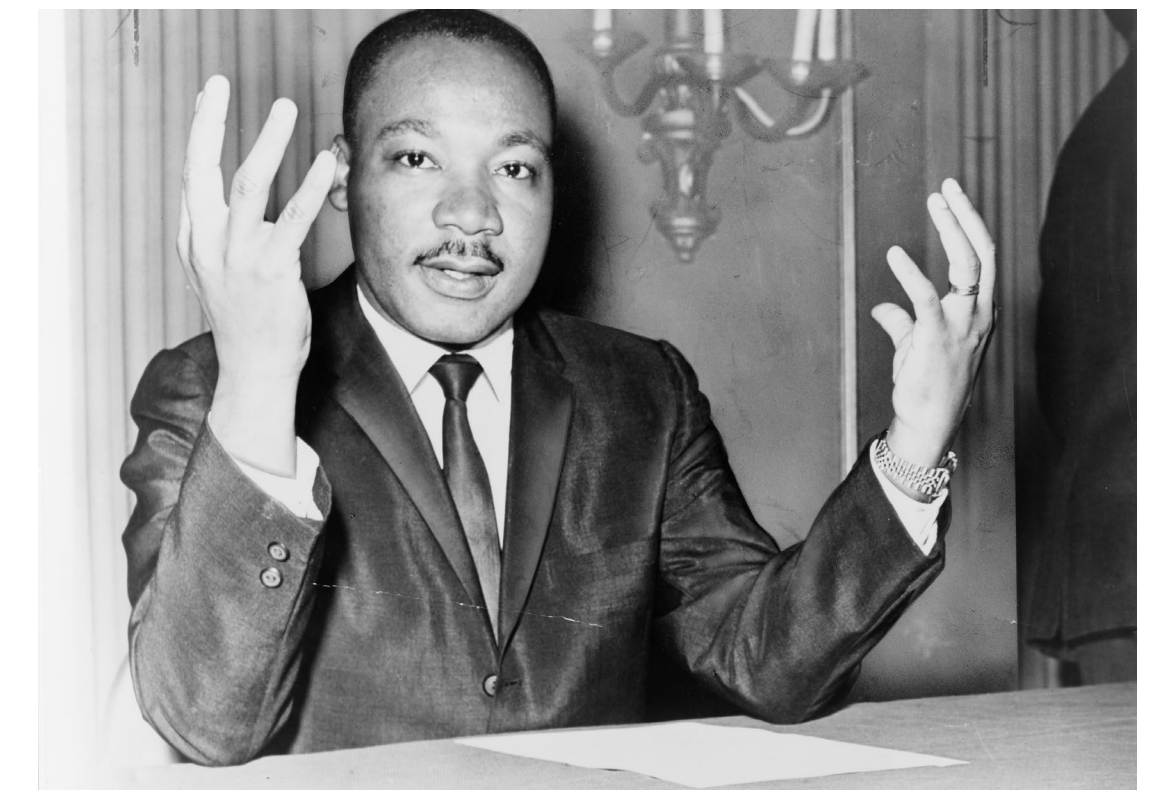
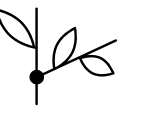
